Background

The University of St Andrews Hockey Club is looking to recruit a part time umpire to work with the club in the 2018/19 season. Although the University Club has predominantly benefitted from a good number of student umpires we have seen a great benefit of working with external umpires for Wednesday and weekend fixtures. We have both Wednesday and weekend matches requiring Level 1 or higher qualified umpires on a regular basis during the university semester. Our schedule is relatively flexible so that we can make the match times work for individuals with specific needs.

We are actively seeking applications in the form of a covering letter and CVs from enthusiastic, highly motivated and aspiring umpires looking to help the club continue to help student umpires develop and to provide expert officiating.

Depending on experience there could be further opportunities to get involved in various other projects depending on the candidate.

- Minimum of Scottish Hockey Level 1 or C badge qualification (the higher the qualification the better)
